### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to early education funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

#### 1 Section 64 of chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended in line 9, by adding after the word "year" the following words:-; and

- 3 provided further, that 32.5 percent of the funds shall be appropriated for the purposes of early
- 4 education to supplement, not offset, any reduction in the general appropriation act from the
- 5 previous fiscal year.
