### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Meredith Mingolelli-Cotter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the trial court of the
2	commonwealth shall establish a sick leave bank for Meredith Mingolelli-Cotter, an employee of
3	the trial court. Any employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
4	personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Meredith Mingolelli-Cotter. If
5	Meredith Mingolelli-Cotter terminates employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the
6	sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court
7	paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or
8	disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial
9	court.
