**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Amelia Alex, an employee of the Department of Social Services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of Social
2 Services shall establish a sick leave bank for Amelia Alex, an employee of the Department of
3 Social Services for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Any employee of the Department of
4 Social Services may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick
5 leave bank for use by Amelia Alex. If Amelia Alex terminates employment with the Department
6 of Social Services or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick
7 leave bank shall be transferred to the Department of Social Services paid leave bank. Sick leave
8 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
9 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Department of Social Services.
