An Act relative to the expansion of the residential tax exemption in the town of Provincetown.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 25 of the acts of 2018 is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out the words "or (ii)" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- (ii) not more than 4
- 3 units of a residential multi-unit parcel occupied by either the taxpayer of the property and used as
- 4 their principal residence for income tax purposes or a resident of the town of Provincetown, who
- 5 occupies the unit on a year-round rental basis and is used as their principal residence for income
- 6 tax purposes; or (iii).
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
