An Act authorizing the town moderator of the town of Monson to act as an election officer in certain elections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 15 of chapter 54 of the General Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, the town moderator in the town of Monson may act as an  
3 election officer for any state or presidential primary or state election; provided, however, that  
4 said town moderator shall not act as an election officer where their name appears on the ballot.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
