An Act relative to housing court jurisdiction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 185C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4 through 9, inclusive, the words "arising in
- 3 the city of Boston in the case of that division, in the counties of Berkshire, Franklin, Hampden
- 4 and Hampshire in the case of the western division and within the cities and towns included in the
- Worcester county division, northeastern division and southeastern division, in the case of those
- 6 divisions,".
- 7 SECTION 2. Said section 3 of said chapter 185C, as so appearing, is hereby further
- 8 amended by striking out, in lines 34 through 38, inclusive, the words "the city of Boston, in the
- 9 case of that division, Berkshire, Franklin, Hampden and Hampshire counties, in the case of the
- western division and within the cities and towns included in the Worcester county division,
- 11 northeastern division and southeastern division, in the case of".
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon passage.
