

SENATE No. 2671

Senate, February 22, 2024 -- Text of the Senate amendment (Senator Comerford) to the House Bill authorizing the town of Bernardston to continue the employment of fire chief Peter Shedd (House, No. 4064).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Peter Shedd,
2 chief of the Bernardston fire department, may continue to serve in such position until Peter
3 Shedd reaches 70 years of age, retires or is not reappointed, whichever occurs first. No
4 deductions shall be made from the regular compensation of Peter Shedd pursuant to chapter 32
5 of the General Laws subsequent to Peter Shedd reaching the age of 65 in connection with Peter
6 Shedd’s service to the town for retirement or pension purposes. Upon retirement, Peter Shedd
7 shall receive a superannuation retirement allowance equal to that which Peter Shedd would have
8 been entitled had he retired upon reaching the age of 65.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
