## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Dennis Annear, 2 an on-call firefighter in the town of Rowe, may continue to serve in such position until they 3 reach the age of 68, the date of their retirement or the date they are removed or suspended from 4 office, whichever occurs first; provided, however, that they remain physically and mentally 5 capable of performing the duties of the position; provided further, that Dennis Annear shall, at 6 the expense of the town of Rowe, be examined by an impartial physician designated by the town 7 to determine such capability. No deductions shall be made from the regular compensation of 8 Dennis Annear pursuant to chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to the 9 effective date of this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
