2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 21, the word "subsection" and
3	inserting in place thereof the following word:- paragraph.
4	SECTION 2. Said section 9 of said chapter 90F, as so appearing, is hereby further
5	amended by striking out, in line 96, the word "subsection" and inserting in place thereof the
6	following word:- paragraph.
7	SECTION 3. Said section 9 of said chapter 90F, as so appearing, is hereby further
8	amended by adding the following paragraph:-
9	(I) A person shall not be disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle under
10	paragraphs (A) or (B) based upon convictions that occurred on or before September 30, 2005,
11	unless: (i) the person has 3 or more convictions for operating under the influence under section
12	24 of chapter 90; or (ii) disqualification from operating a commercial motor vehicle is required
13	under 49 C.F.R. 383.51 or any other federal statute or regulation.
14	SECTION 4. The registrar shall promulgate regulations pursuant to paragraph (C) of

15 section 9 of chapter 90F of the General Laws not later than July 1, 2025.
