An Act relative to embarkation fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 129 of Chapter 46 of the acts of 2003, as amended by Section 11 of
2 Chapter 55 of the acts of 2003, is hereby amended by striking out the figure “\$.50”, each time it
3 appears, and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- \$1.00.

4 SECTION 2. Any city or town who has previously accepted section 129 of Chapter 46 of
5 the acts of 2003, as amended by Section 11 of Chapter 55 of the acts of 2003, may continue to
6 impose previously approved embarkation fees of \$.50 per passenger per departing trip.
