By Mr. Oliveira, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 339) of Jacob R. Oliveira and Patricia A. Duffy for legislation to further regulate receivership of school districts designated as chronically underperforming. Education.

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act further regulating receivership of school districts designated as chronically underperforming.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1k of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3 (L) Upon the board designating a district as chronically underperforming, the
4 commissioner shall, within 60 days thereafter, provide the local school committee with a detailed
5 plan with metrics on how the district may leave receivership. Notwithstanding the foregoing,
6 after a 6-year period of receivership, local control shall be given back to the school district.
