In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act protecting against cyber ransom.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 7D of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 7 by adding the following 2 subsections:-
- 3 (e) No State agency, local government entity, or municipality shall submit payment or
- 4 otherwise communicate with an entity that has engaged in a cybersecurity incident on an
- 5 information technology system by encrypting data and then subsequently offering to decrypt that
- 6 data in exchange for a ransom payment.
- 7 (f) Any State agency or local government entity experiencing a ransom request in
- 8 connection with a cybersecurity incident shall report to and consult with the CIO.
