An Act relative to school safety and security.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 71 is hereby amended by adding the following new section:-
- 2 Section 100. Each school shall conduct a live intruder training session within the first 90
- 3 days of the academic year. The superintendent will work with the principal, teachers and school
- 4 resource officer in each school to schedule and execute said training session. The superintendent,
- 5 principal and school resource officer may alter each training session to reasonably accommodate
- 6 the needs of each student. Notice will be provided to each student's parent or guardian
- 7 explaining the school's intention to hold a live intruder training session within the specified time
- 8 frame.
