An Act relative to school districts in receivership and the Massachusetts School Building Authority.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The second paragraph of section 10 of chapter 70B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following sentence:-

3           (d) Notwithstanding the first sentence of this section, school districts in receivership shall  
4 qualify for incentive percentage points above 80 per cent of eligible costs.
