*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

2 section 18 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

- 3 Section 18. (a) In no case shall an appointment to the registrars of voters be made so as to
- 4 cause the board to have more than 2 members from any established political party in the

5 commonwealth, including the city or town clerk.

- 6 (b) Subsection (a) shall apply to the makeup of the original registrars of voters and in
- 7 each succeeding appointment and in filling vacancies of the registrar of voters.
