# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act requiring tax return disclosure to appear on a presidential primary ballot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 28 of chapter 53 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph:- The state secretary
3	shall not place on the presidential primary ballot the name of any candidate who has not, at least
4	sixty days in advance of the primary date, made public and readily available the candidate's
5	federal income tax returns, as defined in section 6103(b)(1) of the United States internal revenue
6	code, for the immediately previous four years. The state secretary may promulgate regulations to
7	implement this paragraph.
