## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to support cannabis equity businesses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following subsection:-
- 3 (m) The cannabis control commission, in consultation with the Massachusetts cannabis
- 4 advisory board, shall create a searchable online database of all operational cannabis dispensaries
- 5 that allows users to identify economic empowerment applicants, social equity program
- 6 participants, disadvantaged business enterprises, unionized organizations, organizations under
- 7 investigation, and other criteria identified by the commission and advisory board available on the
- 8 commission's website no later than Dec. 31, 2024.
