In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to encourage equitable cannabis business ownership.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	The cannabis control commission, in consultation with the Massachusetts cannabis
2	advisory board, the cannabis social equity advisory board, and the executive office of housing
3	and economic development, and grassroots or non-profit organizations led by formerly
4	incarcerated people, shall conduct a public awareness campaign to highlight the programs and
5	resources available to cannabis business applicants from communities harmed by the war on
6	drugs and other disadvantaged businesses.
