The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to association health plans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Nothwithstanding any general or special rule to the contrary to the maximum extent
- 2 allowed by federal law a Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement or Association Health Plan
- 3 shall be allowed to operate in the Commonwealth, provided that it meets the following
- 4 requirements:
- 5 1. The arrangement shall at all times be in compliance with federal law and regulation,
- 6 including but not limited to the US Department of Labor's regulations regarding Association
- 7 Health Plans.
- 8 2. The arrangement's governing documents shall require the arrangement to be
- 9 actuarially sound, and the arrangement shall in fact be actuarially sound.
