The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to support college students in recovery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 45 the 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 46. (a) Each public institution of higher education that provides housing for
- 4 students shall establish a college campus recovery-focused housing program to provide an
- 5 alcohol and drug-free environment for students recovering from substance use disorder. This
- 6 program shall provide services including, but not limited to, trauma informed on-site counseling,
- 7 mentoring, and peer support. (b) Each public institution of higher education shall provide
- 8 overdose training to all students, faculty, and staff and shall make naloxone available for the
- 9 purpose of treating overdoses, as appropriate.
