The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to benefits for court officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to the contrary, any court
- 2 officer regularly and permanently employed by the trial court who transferred from any county
- 3 sheriff's department on or after January 1, 1998, shall be entitled to have his years of prior
- 4 service during which he was regularly and permanently employed by that sheriff's department
- 5 count toward his vacation benefits in the trial court.
