In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)

An Act relative to relieving minors of income tax obligations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of Chapter 62 of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
2 striking the first sentence and replacing it with the following:-

3 “Residents over the age of 18 shall be taxed on their taxable income, and non-residents
4 over the age of 18 shall be taxed to the extent specified in section 5A on their taxable income, as
5 follows”.
