An Act to promote public safety and certainty related to child deaths.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 38 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 2A the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 2B. In the case of the death of a child under the age of two, the chief medical  
4 examiner shall review and approve: (i) the findings and report of the medical examiner  
5 performing the autopsy to determine the cause of death; and (ii) any change to the autopsy  
6 report.
