An Act relative to protecting our waterways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 12 of Chapter 90B of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2022
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in the first paragraph, by inserting after the words “ by
3 members of the state police,” the following: “by deputy sheriffs”

4 SECTION 2: Section 10G of Chapter 21A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
5 hereby amended, in the first paragraph, by inserting after the words “by members of the state
6 police,” the following: “by deputy sheriffs”
