An Act to require liability insurance for gun ownership.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2           Section 207. (a) Whoever possess, carries or owns a firearm, rifle or shotgun without a  
3 liability policy or bond or deposit required by the provisions of this chapter, which has not been  
4 provided and maintained in accordance therewith, shall be punished by a fine of not less than  
5 500 nor more than 5,000 dollars or by imprisonment for not more than one year in a house of  
6 correction, or both such fine and imprisonment. This section shall not apply to a person who  
7 possesses a firearm, rifle or shotgun on a temporary basis while on the premises of a licensed gun  
8 club.

9           (b) The commissioner of insurance shall promulgate regulations setting forth the  
10   minimum terms of liability insurance policies which shall satisfy the requirements of this section.
