An Act relative to concurrent service for elected officials.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or agency or commission opinion to the  
2 contrary, elected members of a select board or town council in the commonwealth shall not be  
3 prohibited from serving concurrently as elected members of any county legislative board, body,  
4 or assembly and shall not be prohibited from participating in and voting on all matters before  
5 those bodies that may affect the municipality they represent.
