An Act relative to silencers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10A of chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “firearm,” in line 11 the
3 following words:- , including any combination of parts, designed or redesigned, and intended for
4 use in assembling or fabricating any such instrument, attachment, weapon or appliance, and any
5 part intended only for use in such assembly or fabrication, .

6 SECTION 2. Said section 10A of said chapter 269, as so appearing, is hereby further
7 amended by striking out, in line 16, the words “or appliance” and inserting in place thereof the
8 following words:- , appliance or parts.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
