**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

1 *Ordered*, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the House
2 Bill honoring, empowering, and recognizing our servicemembers and veterans (House, No.
3 4671) (the committee on Ways and Means having recommended that the bill be amended by
4 striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the text of Senate
5 document numbered 2817) shall be placed in the Orders of the Day for a second reading on
6 Thursday, June 13, 2024.

7 All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
8 5:00 P.M, on Tuesday, June 11, 2024. All such amendments shall be second reading-
9 amendments to the Senate Ways and Means new text (Senate, No. 2817), but further
10 amendments in the third degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further
11 specify the procedure and format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.

12 After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third
13 time and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no
14 amendments shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the
15 committee on Bills in the Third Reading.
