1	Ordered, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the Senate
2	Bill to reduce plastics (Senate, No. 570) (the committee on Ways and Means having
3	recommended that the bill be amended by substituting a new draft (Senate, No. 2830) shall be
4	placed in the Orders of the Day for a second reading on Thursday, June 20, 2024.
5	All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
6	5:00 P.M, on Tuesday, June 18, 2024. All such amendments shall be second reading-
7	amendments to the Senate Ways and Means new draft (Senate, No. 2830), but further
8	amendments in the third degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further
9	specify the procedure and format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.
10	After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third
11	time and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no

- 12 amendments shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the
- 13 committee on Bills in the Third Reading.
