1 *Ordered*, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the House
2 Bill relative to treatments and coverage for substance use disorder and recovery coach licensure
3 (House, No. 4758), to be reported by the committee on Ways and Means with a recommended
4 new text Senate document numbered 2898, on Monday, July 29, 2024, and read into the Senate
5 Journal on Monday, July 29, 2024, shall be placed in the Orders of the Day for a second reading
6 on Tuesday, July 30, 2024, with the Ways and Means new text S2898 pending.

7 All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
8 5:00 P.M., on Monday, July 29, 2024. All such amendments shall be second reading-
9 amendments to the Senate Ways and Means new text (Senate, No. 2898), but further
10 amendments in the third degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further
11 specify the procedure and format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.

12 After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third
13 time and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no
14 amendments shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the
15 committee on Bills in the Third Reading.
