**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to insurance discounts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special laws to the contrary, motor vehicle insurance
2 companies shall have the option of offering insurance discounts to licensed operators of motor
3 vehicles who complete a marijuana impairment education course. The course may be offered by
4 accredited driving schools and insurance companies, pending approval from the commissioner of
5 insurance, and the course curriculum must include a module on the dangers of driving under the
6 influence of marijuana.
