An Act relative to acceptance of AP scores for college credit.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding after section 45 the following section:-

3 Section 46. The department of higher education is hereby directed to promulgate  
4 regulations establishing a standard whereby college credit is guaranteed at state colleges and  
5 universities for students who achieve an advanced placement exam score of 3 or higher.
