**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court

An Act relative to equitable court staffing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended in Section 10 by adding after the words “northern Berkshire;”:-
3 “district court of Edgartown;”
4 and hereby further amended in Section 10 by adding after the words “western Hampden;”
5 “district court of Nantucket;”.
