**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to domestic violence reports and confidentiality.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 97D the
2 following section:-

3 Section 97D½. (a) There shall be a task force established to complete a systematic review
4 of the laws pertaining to domestic violence and sexual assault reports and confidentiality. The
5 task force shall consist of: the attorney general or a designee; the president of the Massachusetts
6 District Attorneys Association or a designee; the colonel of the state police or a designee; the
7 executive director of Massachusetts office for victim assistance or a designee; 2 members
8 appointed by the senate president, 1 of whom shall represent domestic or sexual violence
9 programs in the Commonwealth, have experience working directly with survivors of domestic
10 and sexual violence, or be a survivor of domestic or sexual violence; 2 members appointed by
11 the speaker of the house of representatives, 1 of whom shall represent domestic or sexual
12 violence programs in the Commonwealth, have experience working directly with survivors of

13 domestic and sexual violence, or be a survivor of domestic or sexual violence; 1 member
14 appointed by the minority leader of the senate; 1 member appointed by the minority leader of the
15 house of representatives; and 2 persons appointed by the governor, 1 of whom shall represent
16 domestic or sexual violence programs in the Commonwealth, have experience working directly
17 with survivors of domestic and sexual violence, or be a survivor of domestic or sexual violence.
18 The members of the task force shall appoint a chair.

19 (b) The task force shall: (i) assess the adequacy of laws pertaining to domestic violence,
20 sexual assault, and confidentiality including, but not limited to, section 97D of chapter 41 of the
21 General Laws; (ii) identify and review the impact of said section 97D; and (iii) develop
22 recommendations to ensure confidentiality of domestic violence survivors without protecting
23 perpetrators.

24 (c) The task force shall submit a report of its findings and legislative recommendations to
25 the clerks of the senate and the house of representatives and the chairs of the joint committee on
26 the judiciary not later than 18 months after the effective date of this act. The task force shall
27 determine if subsequent reports shall be necessary to properly address this issue.
