An Act relative to consolidating multiple definitions of employee.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 148B of Chapter 149, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking the words “chapter 151”, in line 1, and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following:-

4           “chapters 151 and 152,”

5           SECTION 2. Section 1 of Chapter 152, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of  
6 paragraph (4) the following:-

7           “Any reference to an employee shall have the same meaning as in section 148B of  
8 Chapter 149 of the General Laws.”
