**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to additional inspectors; inspector engaging in plumbing or gas fitting work.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended in section 4J, in subsection (b), by inserting after the words “building inspection,” the
- 3 following:- plumbing inspection, gas fitting inspection,
