An Act to finance the Betsy Lehman Center’s statewide provider health care safety education pilot program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special rule to the contrary, the treasurer shall transfer a  
2 total of \$1,500,000 from the Board of Registration in Medicine Trust Fund established in section  
3 35M of chapter 10 of the General Laws to the Betsy Lehman Center for Patient Safety and  
4 Medical Error Reduction, to support implementation of the roadmap to health care safety for  
5 Massachusetts, including a pilot program of electronic health record safety event monitoring and  
6 a statewide program of health care safety education.
