**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act to clarify prescription monitoring program activities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 24A of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (m) the following subsection:-

3 (n) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(1), the department shall exclude testosterone from the
4 list of drugs monitored in the prescription drug monitoring system.

5 SECTION 2. Immediately upon passage of this Act, the department shall delete from the
6 prescription monitoring system established under said section 24A any existing data concerning
7 the prescribing and dispensing of testosterone.
