**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to harbormasters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g), and further under the subparagraph title of "Group 2", of section 3 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the most recent edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the words, "Cushing hospital" the following words:- "employees of a city or town
4 who are employed as Harbormasters and assistant Harbormasters, and appointed pursuant to
5 chapter 102 of the General Laws.
