An Act relative to post retirement earnings and hours limitations for certain professional services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, Chapter 32  
2 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is amended in  
3 Section 91(b) by adding at the end of the paragraph, the following:

4           Any person providing actuarial, auditing, accounting or legal services to a retirement  
5 board is exempt from the earnings and hours limitations outlined herein.
