An Act relative to the definition of Group 4 of the retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The definition of Group 4, as set forth in chapter 32, section 3, paragraph (2),  
2   subparagraph (g) of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby  
3   amended by adding thereto the words: employees of the Commonwealth who are employed as  
4   steam fireman/co-generation, third class engineer/co-generation, second class engineer/co-  
5   generation, first class engineer/co-generation and chief engineer/co-generation.
