An Act establishing job permanency for MADOC instructors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           “Any provisional Industrial Instructor in the Department of Correction will be eligible  
2 and be made permanent within their current job title after twelve months of employment within  
3 said department.”
