An Act relative to the retirement rights of criminal prosecutors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word “more” the words:— , assistant attorney general for criminal  
3 matters which shall include individuals whose primary responsibility is the prosecution of  
4 criminal matters on behalf of the attorney general, as so certified by the attorney general.
