An Act regarding retirement of public authority law enforcement employee groups.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-

3 The Massachusetts Port Authority may elect to improve the retirement group  
4 classification for any group of law enforcement employees who are members of the  
5 Massachusetts Port Authority Retirement System by a majority vote of the authority governing  
6 board. Nothing in this act shall be construed as authorization to diminish the retirement benefits  
7 of public employees by placing any group of employees in a lower group of classification.
