**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to Title 5 income tax credit reform.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6(i) of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2022 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 273 the figure “\$15,000” and inserting in place
3 thereof the following:-- “\$25,000”; and, by striking in line 277 the figure “\$1,500” and inserting
4 in place thereof the following:-- “\$4,000”; and by striking in line 279 the figure “\$6,000” and
5 inserting in place thereof the following:-- “\$10,000.”
