**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act to replace the motor vehicle excise tax with a gas tax adjustment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 60A of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

2 SECTION 2. Section 3A of said chapter 64A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph:-

4 Each municipality shall submit to the department of revenue a comprehensive list of all
5 vehicles registered within its jurisdiction, along with a calculation of the revenue that would have
6 been collected under Chapter 60A had it been in effect. The commissioner shall use this
7 information, in addition to forecasting if necessary, to calculate an adjustment to the tax per
8 gallon necessary to collect the total estimated amount of revenue that would have been collected
9 by all municipalities had the provisions of Chapter 60A been in effect. The commissioner shall
10 then dispense to each municipality the amount that the municipality would have collected had
11 Chapter 60A been in effect.
