**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court

An Act relative to veteran work-off property tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 17A. Section 5N of chapter 59, as appearing in the 2022 official edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 16 and 43, the figure '\$1,500' and inserting in place
3 thereof, in each instance, the following figure:- '\$2,000'.
