An Act relative to municipal tax collectors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking the final paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3 “The collector may, in his discretion, waive such interest, charges and fees, up to 50% of
4 the total tax liability for any given tax period.”
