An Act relative to cyber procurement projects.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 30B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 23 the following new section:-

3 Section 24. Any state agency procuring information technology goods or services shall  
4 give preference to vendors which carry cybersecurity insurance. This section shall not be  
5 construed to preclude vendors without cybersecurity insurance from submitting solicitations to  
6 the state or being awarded bids by the state for information technology goods or services.
