**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act establishing Getting to Zero Week.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart December first through the  
2 eighth as Getting to Zero Week to increase public awareness, understanding, and recognition of  
3 our communities’ shared commitment to end the HIV and AIDS epidemic in the Commonwealth  
4 by getting to zero new cases, zero HIV-related deaths, and zero stigma. The proclamation shall  
5 recommend that the week in December be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
